

## ROHS Declaration

EU Directive 2015/863/EU (RoHS III) modernised Directive 2011/65/EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

This Directive prohibits the use of the following named substances in concentrations of

- more than 0.1 mass percent per homogeneous material for
  - o Lead,
  - o Mercury,
  - o Hexavalent chromium,
  - o Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
  - o Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE),
  - o Di-(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP),
  - o Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP),
  - o Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
  - o Di-isobutyl phthalate (DIBP) or
- more than 0.01 mass percent per homogeneous material for
  - o Cadmium

in products placed on the market in the EU.

We hereby certify that to the best of our knowledge the products supplied by us comply with the above mentioned directive. Exceedances of the above mentioned concentrations shall only be accepted by us if they are covered by Annex II (Exceptions) of the above mentioned directive.

In accordance with the directive, anyone who places a product with a CE Mark on the market automatically undertakes to comply with the ROHS Directive.

We also give assurance that we observe the compliance with the directive in the case of products that do not bear the CE Mark.

However, we are also dependent on the assistance of our suppliers. A corresponding survey of the potentially hazardous ingredients in our purchased parts is currently underway. As soon as we become aware that a hazardous ingredient is contained in a part, we inform our suppliers and work with them to find alternatives.

## REACH Declaration

Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH).

MC Technologies hereby confirms that it acts as a downstream user (producer of articles) in accordance with the above-mentioned regulation.

The products supplied by MC Technologies are not subject to notification or registration. The total quantity of substances contained in the candidate list does not regularly exceed 1 t/a.
